This memorandum is in response to your inquiry regarding a single case study and it's publication in the UT Translation journal.

Research is defined by federal regulations for the protection of human subjects (45 CFR 46) as "a systematic investigation, including research development, testing and evaluation, designed to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge".

A single case study does not meet the definition of "research" under federal regulations and therefore IRB review is not required. If your plans change and you would like to study more than one patient, please submit additional information to our office as a separate determination regarding IRB review and approval will be required.

Please be aware that HIPAA regulations permit case studies provided patient confidentiality is protected. This means your case study cannot contain any information that would identify the patient. Any information that might easily allow identification should never be used in publications or external presentations. Thank you in advance for adhering to those requirements.
